THE DEVIL AT WORK

There is a question that my amazing wife Kay likes to ask...one that she most certainly knows the answer to; "Where is the devil most active?" The response she's looking for is "In the Church!" Which is most certainly true as he has already (for the time being) got control of the secular world, so it's the Church that he and his minions are chiefly warring against. If he can't destroy us, which he can't (Matthew 16:18), he will do his "darnedest" to neutralize our effectiveness and witness. Nowhere was this more evident to us than yesterday in our 10 O'clock Tuesday Bible study. Let me set the stage for you. There were about 30 of us gathered in the church (Please realize that there is room for more) ready to dive into the latter part of chapter 2 in John's 1st Epistle; 1 John 2:15-29. This section of Scripture starts off with the warning not to love the world; and in doing so also the "Prince of this World", Satan, because it's a recipe for disaster.
